APRIL 12, 2022

The Board of Commissioners of Screven County, Georgia, Mr. Will Boyd, Vice-Chairman, Mr. John O. Triplett, Ms. Allison Willis, Mr. Edwin Lovett, Ms. Rosa Romeo and Mr. Mike Dixon met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. on April 12, 2022, at the Screven County Courthouse.

CALL TO ORDER, INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairman Boyd called the meeting to order. Commissioner Warren gave the invocation and lead the pledge of allegiance.

AGENDA APPROVAL

Commissioner Romeo made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Warren seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote.

MINUTES

Consideration to approve the minutes for the March 8, 2022 meeting has been postponed until the next commissioner's meeting on May 10, 2022.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

NEW BUSINESS

(1) Discussion Commissioner Triplett discussed department budget request made by each department for the new fiscal year 2022-2023. Commissioner Willis would like for the minutes to reflect that this budget meeting was not open to the public.

(2) Discussion The board scheduled the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget workshop for May 3, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

(3) Discussion Commissioner Warren made a motion to purchase three used fire trucks from Monroe County for \$4900 each using Contingency Funds. Commissioner Lovett seconded the motion. Chairman Boyd, Commissioner Romeo, and Commissioner Triplett are all in favor of this motion. Commissioner Willis and Commissioner Dixon opposed. The motion carried by majority vote. Due to this item not being listed on the agenda, the motion cannot stand and will be discussed at a later date.

COMMISSION/STAFF COMMENTS

Commissioner Romeo stated that she was informed anonymously of coaches acting inappropriately at the Recreation Department. Commissioner Warren discussed being approached by many residents inquiring about the lack of business opportunities in Screven County. Lagina Evans gave an update on the renovations to the hospital and many upcoming events.
